

# Requirements for K-12 and Secondary Teacher Education Programs Elementary Education, Early Childhood, Special Education, Middle School

## Enrollment in EDC150

- Required course for Middle School & Special Education
- Secondary Education Majors: Music (MUS148), Agriculture (AGE318)
- Concurrent enrollment allowed with SEC 302 if 45 > hrs. completed and a combined 2.50 GPA, w/SPE 310 if 30 > hrs. completed w/combined 2.50 GPA >
- Student Contract & disposition checklist completed
- Transfer students who have education course credit should contact the Secondary Education Office at 836-5944.

## Enrollment in ELE302, SEC302, SPE310, KIN200, MUS200

- 30 hrs. completed for ELE 302, SPE 310
- 45 hrs. completed for SEC 302, KIN 200, MUS 200
- EDC 150 if required
- Combined 2.50 GPA >
- Pre-professional liability insurance required for all courses requiring a clinical experience
- Attempt the MoGEA and Complete the MEP1. (Post-Bacs exempt from MoGEA)

## Admission to Teacher Education Program

- Passed professional portfolio 1<sup>st</sup> checkpoint if required of your program
- Current Family Care and Safety Registry background check on file
- EDC 150 if required
- COM 115 completed with a 'C' >
- ELE 302, SEC 302, SPE 310, KIN 200, MUS 200 completed with a 'C', Exception: ELE Majors – 'B' or > in Prof Eds
- All sections of the MoGEA passed (Post Bacs exempt)
- Completion of the MEP1
- **Effective fall 2013:** 2.75 combined GPA >, Exception: HST majors - 3.00 content (major) GPA >
- **Prior to fall 2013:** 2.50 combined GPA > and 2.50 content (major) GPA >; Exception: HST majors - 2.75 content GPA/ELEM ED 2.75 combined GPA
- Approval of the Professional Education Committee (PEC)

## Enrollment in all Professional Education courses beyond ELE302, SEC302, SPE310, MUS200, or KIN200

- When requirements are met, PEC will evaluate your credentials for admission to Teacher Education (T.E.)
- You must be admitted to T.E. to take professional education courses beyond ELE302, SEC302, SPE310, MUS200, or KIN200.
- Consult with your academic advisor regarding pre-registration.
- Appeals are reviewed by the PEC Exceptions & Compliance Committee

## Admission to Supervised Teaching

- Admission to Teacher Education Program
- Passed all Prof. Ed. courses w/grade of 'C' > in each course  
Exception: ELE Majors – 'B' or > in Prof Eds
- Passed Professional Portfolio checkpoint 2
- Completed transition point 2
- Apply for Student Teaching Aug.1 or Feb. 1 the semester prior to Student Teaching
- Pre-Professional Liability Insurance
- Department of major, subject (certification) area and advisor recommendation
- TB test clearance
- Current FBI background check on file

### Prior to fall 2017:

- Combined GPA of 2.50 > (2.75 if ELEM ED, HST)
- Content (major) GPA of 2.50 > (2.75 if HST)

### If completing student teaching spring 2017 and beyond:

- Combined GPA of 2.75 >
- Content (major) GPA of 3.00 >

## Graduation

- File Intent to Graduate
- Take the GEN 499 Exit Exam
- Utilize Career Services (CARR 309)

### Prior to spring 2017:

- Passed the MoPTA at required score at time of graduation
- 2.50 > combined GPA (2.75 - ELEM Ed & History)
- 2.50 > content (major) GPA (2.75 for History)
- 2.50 > professional education GPA
- Grade of 'C' or > in student teaching

### Graduating spring 2017 or later:

- Passed the MoPTA at required score at time of graduation
- 2.75 > combined GPA
- 3.00 > content (major) GPA
- 3.00 > professional education GPA
- Grade of 'C' or > in student teaching  
Exception: ELE Majors – 'B' or > in student teaching

## Recommend for Certification

- All state certification and program requirements must be met and application filed through Missouri State University, Certification Office. Check with your advisor every semester to make certain you are meeting all requirements and are aware of any state certification changes.
- Passing score for the Content Area Assessment that meets the requirement at the time of your graduation.
- Passing score for the MoPTA performance assessment that meets the requirement at the time of your graduation.
- DESE will require an FBI background check prior to issuing a certificate.
